WHAT'S THE STORY?

Rise of Olympus 100 is the action-packed successor to Play'n GO's 2018 classic, *Rise of Olympus*.

The story picks up where the first game left off, featuring the brothers Hades, Poseidon, and Zeus.

The three sibling Gods split the realms of Olympus between them to rule united and after Cronus' age of tyranny. As powerful as they are individually, their might holds no restriction if united.

This is a tale of three brothers. You decide how the story ends.

FEATURES

Immerse yourself in another Greek Mythology-themed adventure!

The gameplay largely resembles its predecessor on the reels. However, this time, things are cranked up to 100.

Land three Scatter Symbols to commence the Free Spins, where *Rise of Olympus 100* really ups the ante. There's the 100 potential Free Spins and a Multiplier cap of 100 at the player's disposal, so it's triple-digit antics across the board!

If a player fills the charge meter, it launches The Hand of God feature. Choosing between Hades, Poseidon and Zeus, the player's potential rewards hinge on the God's power and the effect on the gameplay.

Hades has the power to transform random Symbols into the same one, completing paylines, Poseidon adds one or two Wilds into random locations on the grid and Zeus removes two LP Symbols, substituting them for Wilds or HP Symbols.

The game also features a Clear the Grid prize, which update's the game's feature multiplier by x50 while also netting the player instant rewards.

MEET THE CHARACTERS

Zeus

Part-time ruler and God of the Sky, Zeus is the protector and father of all humans. Splitting his governing powers amongst his brothers, he's known for his lightning-sharp sharp wit.

Poseidon

The God of the Sea and all things H₂O, Poseidon is often seen with his trusty trident by his side. With a temper as rough as the oceans themselves, you don't want to catch Poseidon on a bad day. Let's just call him the short-tempered brother.

Hades

The stoic brother and God of the Underworld. Hades watches over the nether realm with his three-headed dog Cerberus, often dubbed the merciless God, Hades just wants to catch a break.
